Practical Help. Donating a Future

Doctors from all over Germany are helping to improve the standards of medical care in the underdeveloped areas of Nairobi in Kenya. Lufthansa Cargo makes it possible for these urgently needed doctors to fly to Africa.

Patients are treated in the Cargo Human Care's (CHC) own medical centre, free of charge, in cooperation with local medical institutions in Kenya.

Around 30 medical specialists work in their free time on an honorary basis for CHC. In addition, dozens of Lufthansa Cargo staff and pilots support the project on a voluntary basis.

Apart from the medical assistance, CHC has also taken on responsibility for the children in the Mothers' Mercy Home Orphanage.

As a result, the charitable organisation Cargo Human Care e. V. was founded.

Kenya's people need help

For most people in Kenya medical care is prohibitively expensive. Around 65 % of Nairobi's four million inhabitants live in very basic conditions with no clean water or sanitation.

The situation of children whose parents have died of AIDS is particularly serious. In many cases orphans are HIV positive themselves and need special medical care.

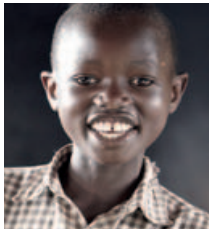




Our Project in focus

Mothers' Mercy Home

The Mothers' Mercy Home Orphanage in Kianjogu was established in 2001 by the Bishop of the Anglican Church, together with the women of the Mount Kenya South Diocese. In 2008, with donated money, Cargo Human Care built a brick house with space for 128 children, where boys and girls are accommodated in 4-bedded rooms.

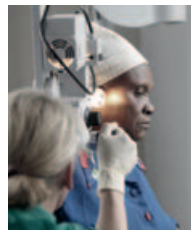


Cargo Human Care Medical Centre

The Cargo Human Care Medical Centre opened in 2009. Local nurses look after the 10,000 local inhabitants who cannot afford medical care. Doctors from Germany work here voluntarily in regular three to four day shifts. The Centre's own pharmacy ensures a constant supply of medicine. In urgent cases the CHC pays for operations or treatment at the nearby Nazareth Hospital.

SOS Medical Centre

In the slums of Buru Buru Cargo Human Care provides outpatient treatment at the SOS Medical Centre and, above all, supports the local medical staff with specialists from Germany.
